### Date and Cost:

We are soliciting names who want to commit to this one day trip to W1AW in Newington, CT.

**Cost:** Probably in the \$40 to \$50 range. The cost is less if we get more attendees. The motorcoaches are either 28, 47, or 54 seating capacity with the smaller costing more than the larger coach.
